II. ACADEMIC GUIDELINES:

1. WORKLOAD:

- a. Students may take no more than **seven** courses a semester. This includes courses taken at FIT, AGI, etc. See the sheet on workload guidelines for more details.
- b. Students on probation may take no more than **six** courses a semester.
2. A course fulfills a given requirement, if the letter in the remarks column corresponds to the letter of the paragraph on the general requirement sheet.
3. Course descriptions and their prerequisites are found in the Yeshiva University Undergraduate Catalog and on the web.
4. **Jewish Studies** courses appear:
 - a. in the general course listing by subject.
 - b. in the back of the book arranged by level. This listing may be more helpful in arranging your CORE program.
