M. Lowengrub and L. Shiffman recommended that the Council look into amending the Faculty Handbook in parts relating to emeritus status, tenure and promotion statements, and size of the Faculty Review Committee.

The Council moved into executive session at 12:40 PM.

W. Stenhouse reminded the Representatives of the need for each faculty body to elect Representatives this spring for service on the Faculty Council beginning fall 2014. The By-laws, as amended in March 2014, indicate the number of Representatives from each unit.
