Subject: Policy Statement on Combating Trafficking in Persons – FAR 52.222-50

The United States Government has adopted a zero tolerance policy regarding contractors and contractor employees that engage in or support the trafficking in persons, procurement of commercial sex acts, or use of forced labor. Pursuant to federal law, Yeshiva University and the Albert Einstein College of Medicine have implemented this policy to oppose forced labor, sex trafficking and related activities, which contribute to the phenomenon of trafficking in persons. It is the policy of our institution that Yeshiva University and the Albert Einstein College of Medicine and its employees will neither engage in nor support such activities and no funds received from the United States Government will be used to support such activities. This policy shall not be construed to prevent medical treatment or the provision of other medical care to any person, or to prohibit those specific activities authorized by rule, regulation, or the terms of any specific grant, award, cooperative agreement or contract. University employees who violate this policy will be subject to appropriate action, including, but not limited to, disciplinary action with penalties up to and including termination.
