### *Guarding* the Floor with #4







It's been 45 years since I played my last game
And since then my life has never been the same
Yet I often look back and still can remember
When basketball was my passion from January through December
That magical time still resides in my head
The excitement and honor of playing for "Red"
The boyhood dreams of basketball glory
Became lessons for life in a wonderful story
We were taught by legends,whose praise I still sing
Like Hank Rosenstein, Nat Militzok, Bobby Kelly, Dolly King
They ingrained in us never to commit the big sin
