



THE BRIDGE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Bridge, a nonprofit social service agency, provides comprehensive rehabilitation services, including supportive housing and behavioral health treatment, to vulnerable New Yorkers. With over 40 programs in Manhattan, Brooklyn, and the Bronx, The Bridge serves more than 2,800 people annually.

Aging Services Intern Description:

- Visit clients living in Bridge supportive housing and provide individual weekly counseling to vulnerable older adults
- Support in case management follow up and community referrals
- Escort when needed to important appointments
- Conduct evidence based assessments such as the PHQ-9, AUDIT and DAST-10
- Attend relevant trainings
- Participate in weekly interdisciplinary team meetings and individual weekly supervision
- Write timely case notes

Requirements/Qualifications:

- Should be comfortable visiting clients in their homes
- Must be a second year MSW or forensic psychology student
- Must be reliable, willing to learn, and able to make sound decisions
- Must pass a background check and SCR clearance
- Must be willing to complete Mandated Reporter trainings as well as required agency trainings
