

## Occupational Therapy Doctorate: Tuition, Fees and Scholarship Information

Yeshiva University's <u>Office of Student Finance</u> maintains current tuition, fees, and refund policies and procedures for all graduate programs. All applicants are automatically considered for scholarships. You do not need to submit any additional information. Awards are determined during the application review process.

The full-time, 115 credit entry-level occupational therapy doctorate program is designed to be completed in 8 semesters. The tuition and fees for the 2023-2024 academic year are listed below.
