- MSW required, LCSW preferred, plus progressively responsible work experience in a related setting.
- Minimum of 5 years supervisory experience
- Successful candidate should have significant, relevant history of work experience in a Clubhouse or similar rehabilitation model with individuals who have serious mental illness or co-occurring disorders
- Strong work ethic and willingness to work flexible hours.
- Excellent verbal, interpersonal and written communication skills, including ability to effectively communicate with internal and external stakeholders.
- Excellent judgment and ability to adapt to situations as they arise by possessing the capability and flexibility and quick thinking with a focus on intervening to de-escalate potential mental health crisis
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- Basic computer proficiency (MS Office Word, Excel, and Outlook).
- Ability to handle crises in a skilled, supportive, and effective manner
- Strong team leadership, collaboration and management skills are required. <u>Fingerprinting and</u> <u>criminal background check required.</u>
